

**RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2007**

The Medina Township Board of Trustees met in regular session at the Medina Township Hall on September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2007, to conduct the business of the Township. President Todd called the meeting to order at 7:09 pm with the following Trustees in attendance: Dianna Huffman, Michael D. Todd and Mead Wilkins. Also in attendance were the Fiscal Officer, Police Chief, Fire Chief, Road Foreman, Assistant Road Foreman, Zoning Inspector, Assistant Zoning Inspector and the general public.

**Roll Call**

Mr. Todd asked for a roll call of all members present. Trustees present were Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

Mr. Todd led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Mr. Todd motioned to open the floor for public comment. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion.

John Varley (4020 Colonial Court) had a complaint regarding noise caused by dirt bikes and loud music.

Michael Baach (3838 Weymouth Woods) asked what the timeline was for the Comprehensive Plan Committee.

Mr. Todd motioned to close the floor for public comment. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion.

**SITE PLANS**

**Russell Park – Panel Signs – 3848 Medina Road**

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve the tenant panels on the identification sign for Russell Park as presented. The panels are for Ron Russell, Lease Information, Lifetime Chiropractic and Federal Credit Union. Each panel will consist of 4.65 square feet. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

**Realty One – Wall Sign**

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve the change in wall signs for Realty One from 17.5 square feet to 25 square feet as presented. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

**Dental Works – Wall Sign**

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve the wall sign for Sears doing business as “Dental Works” not to exceed 36 square feet as presented. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mr. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

**Dental Works - Identification Sign**

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve the replacement panel to reflect Sears doing business as “Dental Works” on the existing identification sign not to exceed 4.3 square feet as presented. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

## SITE PLANS CON'T

### Portrait Innovations – Site – 5001 Grande Shops Avenue

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve the use for Portrait Innovations to locate in Unit I-1 of Medina Grande Shops at 5001 Medina Grande Shops Avenue as presented. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### Portrait Innovations – Sign – 5001 Grande Shops Avenue

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve a wall sign for Portrait Innovations not to exceed 27 square feet as presented. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### Medina Medical Campus – Site – Medina Road/Shady Brook Run

Mr. Todd motioned to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Commission and approve the use for Medina Medical Campus located at the corner of Medina Road and Shady Brook Run as presented. It is so noted that the breezeways need to remain open with the exception in the winter that a temporary vinyl enclosure could be used. The two lots need to be combined into one lot prior to any zoning permits being issued. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### Crystal Clinic - Site

Mr. Todd tabled the Crystal Clinic sign for lack of representation.

### Approval of Payroll

Mr. Todd motioned to approve payroll checks #11383 to #11431 totaling \$32,238.34 with deductions totaling \$2,931.85. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### Approval of Accounts Payable

Mr. Todd motioned to approve accounts payable checks #17931 to #17977 totaling \$107,123.30. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### Fire Department

Chief Crumley reported that for the month of July 2007, the department responded to 42 calls as follows: 15 alarm drops; 3 carbon monoxide; 22 fire calls; 1 motor vehicle accidents; 1 LST assist.

Chief Crumley reported for the month of August 2007, the department responded to 50 calls as follows: 26 alarm drops; 1 carbon monoxide; 1 LST assist; 19 Fire; 1 Hazmat Spill; 2 motor vehicle accidents.

## **REPORTS CON'T**

### **Fire Department Con't**

Chief Crumley said they are in the process of trying to break down the calls between the Combined-Ops of Medina City and Medina Township. Technically there were only 8 calls in August for the Township, the rest were Combined-Ops with the City.

### **Police Department**

Chief Arbogast reported for the month of August 2007, the department responded to 911 calls for service. There were 34 arrests; 72 criminal reports taken; 25 crash reports; 213 cites and warnings; 7 DUI; 283 community policing. The Community Partners Program has begun. September is National Preparedness Month. The department will be participating in COPS and Kids on September 29 and the Reserve Community Days on September 23. Mr. Todd complimented Chief Arbogast on the excellent job he is doing making the Police Department a pro-active department instead of a reactive department by going out into the community doing things that are important to the community not only policing the community. Mr. Wilkins thanked Chief Arbogast for his help at the Rally in the Alley for Coats for Kids.

### **Road Department**

No report.

Mr. Todd motioned to approve the three departmental reports that were presented to the Board. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### **Employee Handbook**

Trina Devanney has some questions regarding the employee handbook. Mr. Wilkins will call her.

### **Audit Update**

Mrs. Huffman asked for an audit update. Mrs. George said she is in contact with the auditors daily. Charles Harris Company said they should have the final audit within a month.

### **Maintenance Building**

The Trustees discussed the cost of the new maintenance building with Kerry Illes. Mr. Todd said the Trustees will make a resolution contingent upon the drawing being put in the record.

**Resolution No. 09062007-~~022~~ 023**

Mr. Todd put forth a resolution to appropriate \$550,000.00 for the building and development of the Road Department Building on Blakslee Park. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### **Refurbishment of the Township Complex**

Mr. Wilkins said the back door in the townhall needs to be replaced because it was put in backwards 23 years ago and the carpeting gets wet. This has created a mold problem. The Department Heads are in the process of creating a plan for the old road department building and the salt shed. They will get a cost estimate.

### **Record Retention Policy**

Mr. Todd reviewed the record retention policy. He asked that the Department Heads review the policy and give their opinion.

### **Video Recorded Meetings**

### **Block Party – Reserve Homeowners Association**

Mr. Todd motioned to approve the closure of traffic on Reserve Drive September 23 from 3 to 7 pm contingent on the approval of the Police and Fire Department. Mrs. Huffman seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### **Changing of Time for September 20th Meeting**

Mr. Todd received correspondence from Carol Shockley stating that the time of the meeting to open the Blakslee Park bids could be changed to a later time.

## **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Mr. Todd motioned to open the floor for public comment. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion.

Michael Baach (3838 Weymouth Woods) asked if the township had access to the Government Cable Access Channel.

Rita Holt (4420 Nettleton Road) commented on preserving historical records. She also asked if there would be restrooms at Blakslee Park.

Mr. Wilkins discussed the Township property on Route 3 (Simon property) that is being farmed right now.

Mr. Todd motioned to close the floor for public comment. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion.

### **Executive Session**

Mr. Todd motioned to enter into Executive Session to discuss employee compensation with the Board of Trustees, the Fiscal Officer and the Police Chief. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins. The Board entered into Executive Session at 8:54 pm. The Board reconvened at 9:21 pm. No decisions were made during that meeting.

Mr. Todd wanted it noted for the record that the Police Department's 2007 budget was lower than the 2006 budget. They have made strident efforts to make the Police Department more cost efficient while maintaining and adding services.

### **Police Information Specialist Raise**

Mr. Todd motioned to approve pay of \$11.00 per hour for the Information Specialist for the Police Department effective September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2007. Mr. Wilkins seconded the motion. Voting aye thereon: Mrs. Huffman, Mr. Todd and Mr. Wilkins.

### **Police Department Structure**

Mr. Todd and Chief Arbogast are still working on the Police structure and he asked that if anyone had any suggestions please contact Chief Arbogast.

### **Selling Items on E-Bay**

Chief Crumley asked if they could sell items on E-bay instead of having an auction. Mrs. George said that Granger Township used a gentleman in Seville who sells on E-bay for a commission and they had good luck doing this. Chief Crumley will contact the gentleman.




**OLD BUSINESS**

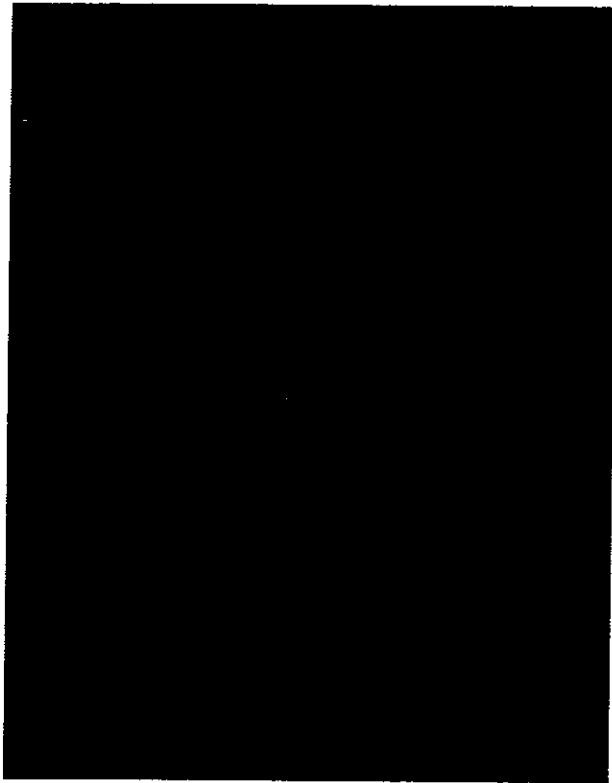

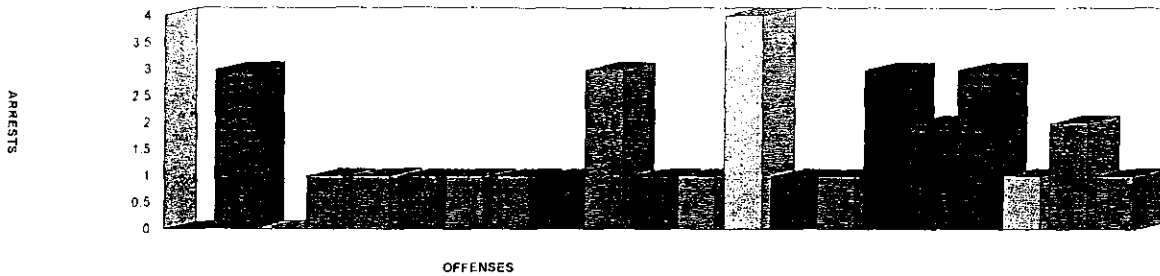

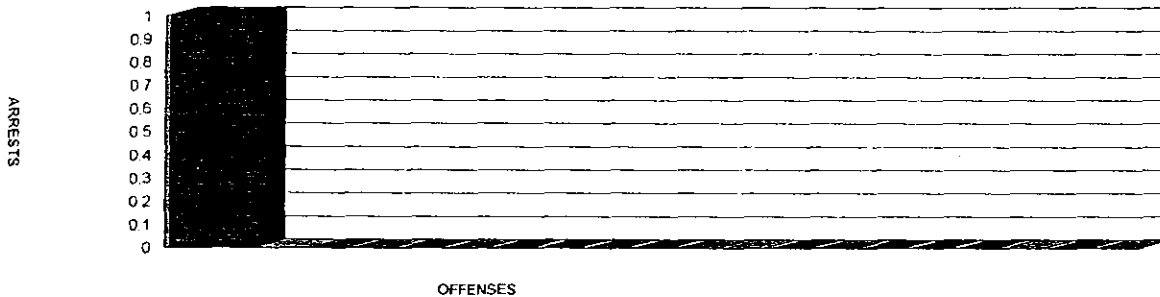
