EXISTING CONDITIONS

- The marble headstone and base are in good condition.
- The marble headstone and base are stained and contain biological growth.
- The marker has settled and is no longer plumb and level.







After (September 2009)

TREATMENT SUMMARY

- A. Excavation/Fragment Recovery
 - 1. Remove marker from ground.
 - 2. Excavate for new compacted gravel foundation.

B. Cleaning

- 1. For removal of biological growth and general soiling, the marble headstone and base are to be cleaned with D/2 Architectural Antimicrobial.
 - a. Clean water at low pressure (max 400 psi) and hand-pump sprayer.
 - b. Natural or nylon bristle brushes.
 - c. Avoid dissolution or erosion of the stone.

C. Re-attachment and Repair

D. Reset and Level

- 1. Reset the base to proper depth, level and plumb, upon a new compacted gravel foundation.
- 2. Reset the headstone to the base upon a thin bed of lime-based mortar and an outer bead of setting compound.

E. Site Preparation and Repair

1. Place pea gravel at base of marker.
